

Evaluation of New Technologies

UnitedHealthcare's Medical Technology Assessment Committee reviews clinical evidence that impacts the determination of whether new technology and health services will be covered.

The Medical Technology Assessment Committee is composed of Medical Directors with diverse specialties and subspecialties from throughout UnitedHealthcare and its affiliated companies, guest subject matter experts when required, and staff from various relevant areas within UnitedHealthcare.

The Committee meets at least 10 times a year to review published clinical evidence, information from government regulatory agencies and nationally accepted clinical position statements regarding new and existing medical technologies and treatments, to assist UnitedHealthcare in making informed coverage decisions.
